RISKS/BENEFITS: There are no known significant potential risks of indverse effects of physical, psychological or medical nature with regard to participation in these activities. Potential risks associated with participation in this research are likely to be low risk, but may include so fety issues when the youth are in their communities collecting information. There will be no direct beautists to subjects participating in this research study. It is likely that this research project will be a legander experience for all youth participants, and foster greater understanding of what they perceive influences we health and wellbeing of their communities.

COMPENSATION: Compensation for participation by youth in this community assessment will be provided by their community agency.

CONFIDENTIALITY: All information confected as part of this study will be stored in a locked cabinet in the university research office. The research entities may have access to study record. All proceedings will remain confidential.
